WHY SHOULD I CHOOSE THE UNIVERSITY OF LONDON?

The University of London, established in 1836, has played an historic and pioneering role in extending university education to all regardless of race, religion, gender or country of residence.

Not only did the University break new ground by admitting any male student who was able to take the degree, but in 1878 it became the first university in the UK to admit women into its halls. Amidst these radical reforms in education access, **further new ground was broken in 1858 with the establishment of the External System, which opened up the degree programme to those who could not come to London to study.** Following the fourth Charter granted and signed by Queen Victoria, this made the University of London the first university to offer degrees to students worldwide, with Mauritius becoming the first overseas country to host its examinations in 1865.

Now, 150 years on, the External System continues to innovate and offers more than 100 academic qualifications, many of which are taught using the latest technologies. The global community of External students now numbers 41,000 across 180 countries worldwide, making it a unique network.

Online Support from University of London

- Laws VLE: The password protected Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) provides a centralised location for accessing many resources. It provides subject guides, discussion forums and facilities for you to set up your own profile page.

- Online legal research exercises designed to build and enhance your ability to find primary and secondary legal materials using electronic sources, and to conduct legal research generally.

- The online library provides access to Justis.com, JSTOR, ABI/INFORM, LexisNexis Professional, Westlaw, Academic Search Premier, Business Source Premier, Casetrack and the UK Statute Law database.
- You will also have access to news items, Examiners' reports, past exam papers, the student handbook, subject guides, the Regulations booklet and reading lists.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS DO I NEED TO REGISTER FOR THE LLB PROGRAMME?

1. Achievement at SPM / O' Levels or its Equivalent

All candidates must have a minimum of **3 credits** which must be obtained in one sitting of the examination.

2. Achievement at STPM / A' Levels or its Equivalent

All candidates must have a minimum of **2 principals** which must be obtained in the one sitting of the examination.

Please note that for **Graduate Entry Routes** students can register for the LLB Programme if they already have a degree awarded by an institution acceptable to the University.

Mature Entry Route

For students who are above 21 years old and have only one A-Level pass or its equivalent can register for the programme. **Students are however cautioned as they may not be able to sit for the CLP as they would not meet the criterion set by the Legal Qualifying Board of Malaysia.** Please refer to the FAQs on CLP on this website for further information.

HOW MUCH WILL THE TOTAL COST BE?

A more detailed breakdown is available by making reference to our fees structure but an estimate for the **3 years** taking into account college fees, fees payable to University of London as well as those payable to the local examination syndicate; the total cost should be between **RM 40000 – RM 42000.**
